November 22, 1967 July 2, 1974 apply on October 1 apply on Jan. 1, 1977

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER ABOUT YOUR APPLICATION

- 1. You may keep your present call sign if:
 - a) You move your present call to another location.
 - b) You apply for your new 2-letter call sign as a second station at a different address than your present call.
- 2. When choosing your two letter callsign:
 - a) Make a list of the 1 X 2 call signs that you prefer in order of their preference. HINT: A list of unassigned calls will be published by the ARRL for each call area. Consult August, QST or Headquarters for details.
 - b) Make your last choice -"Any 1 X 2 call sign presently unassigned"
 - c) Attach your list of preferences to your completed Form 610 with a check or money order for \$ 28.00. Do not forget to sign Form 610 or forget to include your extra class license.
